


PLANNING YOUR EXCURSION DARLINGHURST THEATRE COMPANY

Venue Access & Public Transport

TRAINS

Museum Station is the closest train station and is a ten minute walk to Eternity Playhouse. Alternatively, Central Station is a five minute bus ride away. Visit www.sydneytrains.info for more information.

BUSES

The 389 bus (which runs between Pyrmont and North Bondi via Town Hall) stops close to Eternity Playhouse on the corner of Bourke and Burton Streets. Numerous bus routes also stop on the corner of Oxford and Palmer Streets, a two minute walk from the venue. Visit www.sydneybuses.info for bus timetables.

PARKING & DROP OFF

There is no onsite parking and only limited timed street parking near the theatre. The most appropriate drop off location is by the courtyard on the corner of Kings Lane and Palmer Street, diagonally across the road from the main entrance of Eternity Playhouse.

Accessibility

Eternity Playhouse is an accessible venue.

- There is an accessible entrance for wheelchairs via the main entrance on Burton Street. Please notify a Front of House staff member if you require help with access to the venue.
- There is a lift in the Eternity Playhouse foyer that can take patrons to all levels of Eternity Playhouse, including the theatre.
- The theatre can accommodate patrons in wheelchairs.
- A hearing loop is installed in the theatre, which operates only with hearing aids equipped with the telephone coil (T-Switch).

If members of your group require the hearing loop facility, have limited mobility or other access requirements please notify the Box Office at the time of booking to ensure that they are seated appropriately, as the theatre does have allocated seating.

Arrival

Please ensure that your group arrives 30 minutes prior to the performance start time. Performances will commence promptly at the advertised time, late comers may be excluded or asked to wait for an appropriate interval in the performance.

Collecting Your Tickets

The Box Office at Eternity Playhouse opens one hour prior to every performance for ticket collection. Proof of purchase or a valid photo ID must be presented when collecting tickets. For any further ticketing related enquiries please call the Box Office on 02 8356 9987.

Food & Drink

Food and drink are permitted inside the Eternity Playhouse foyer, but not inside the auditorium.

The Eternity Playhouse bar has a selection of beverages and bar snacks. Located in the bustling lower Oxford Street precinct, the theatre is surrounded by an array of cafes and restaurants. If travelling with a packed lunch, Hyde Park is an eight minute walk from the venue.

School Bags

Large bags and luggage are not permitted into the Eternity Playhouse auditorium. There will be a designated bag drop area in the foyer which will be pointed out to you on the day. The Eternity Playhouse has a relatively small foyer space so we request that teachers and students do not bring large bags/backpacks with them to the performance where possible.

Darlinghurst Theatre Company is not responsible for lost or stolen goods left in the bag drop area.
